# About The Kiwanis Festival of the Performing Arts

---

The Kiwanis Festival for the Performing Arts (Stratford) began in 1927. The Festival now runs 3 weeks every April and is managed by a small part-time staff and over 100 volunteers. We are a registered charity (887047199 RR0001) supported by donations, sponsorships, and participant registration fees and governed by an Organizing Committee headed by Kiwanians named as Trustees by the Kiwanis Club of Stratford.

## MILESTONES

- 1927** - Music teachers, led by WB Rothwell, organized the Stratford Music Festival featuring competitions in voice, piano, strings and school choirs.
- 1941** - The festival, now grown in size and popularity, was one of the few in Canada to remain in operation through the war years.
- 1952** - Volunteers from the Kiwanis Club of Stratford assumed responsibility for Festival administration.
- 1967** - The “Kiwanis Music Festival of Stratford” was granted Charitable Status.
- 1980** - The music festival expanded its syllabus to include competitions in dance, guitar, jazz, and rock and roll bands.
- 2008** -The festival was renamed “Kiwanis Festival of the Performing Arts”.
- 2020** -The festival was canceled for the first time since 1927 due to COVID pandemic.
- 2021** - During pandemic shutdown, this venerable event showed its resilience by going online for the first time!
- 2022** -Pandemic shutdown continued so KFPA remained virtual for a second year
- 2023** -Pandemic shutdown had lifted so KFPA offered a hybrid festival for the first time – virtual and live classes
- 2024** - KFPA is again offered participants their choice of entering virtually or live

Today, our festival operates as an independent charity, administered by Executive Director Pat McKinna, managed by a volunteer Organizing Committee headed by Kiwanis Trustees, and generously supported by the local business community and individual donors. Won't you join that family??

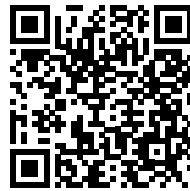


# Festival General Rules

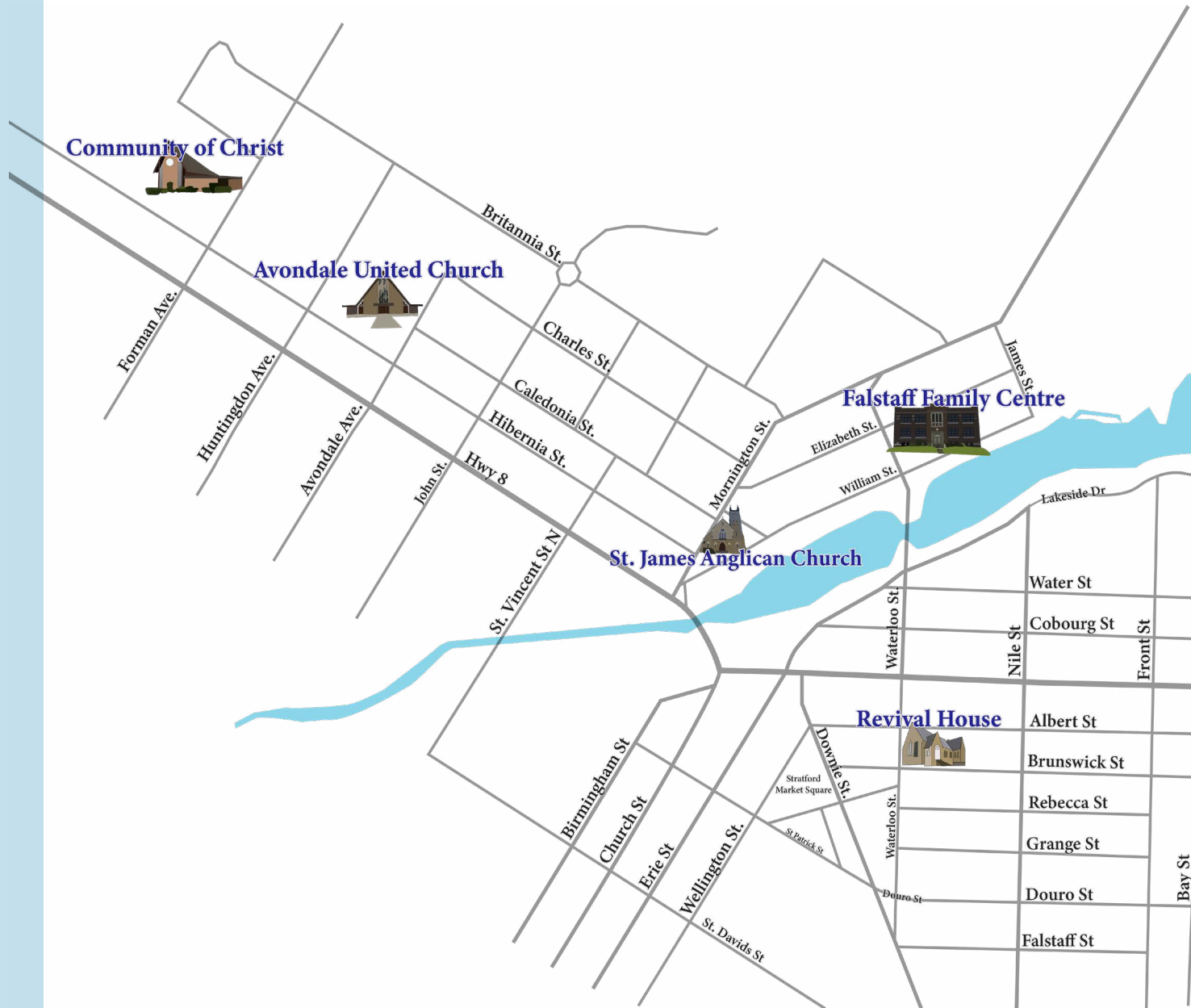

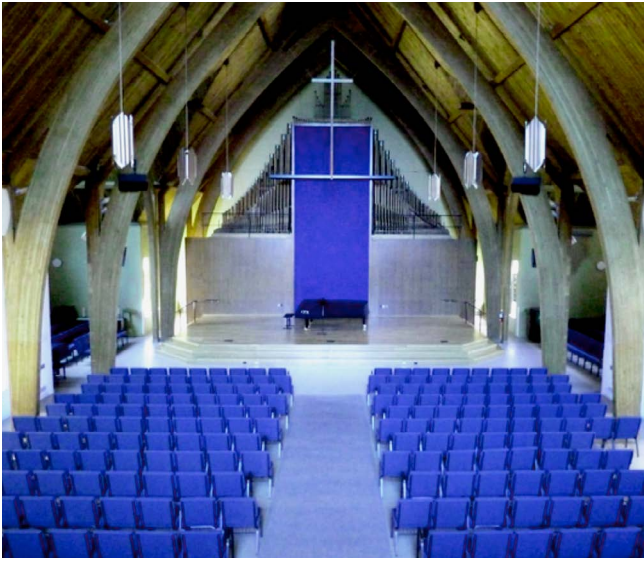

## 2024 FINALS

### Revival house



Housed in the historic building formerly known as The Church Restaurant, Revival House is a jewel in Stratford's architectural crown. KFPA finalists will have the opportunity to perform in that professional performance setting with both adjudicators and the general public present. Rather than have one final per category, finalists from all categories each week will be invited to one Final each week on Friday night at 7pm. Both virtual and live entrants are eligible for trophies and awards so participation is not required but this is a unique opportunity to perform in a special space and for a different audience. Participants can contact Revival House to visit and check out the performance space before the final.

# Week One

Friday April 19 included performances from this week's categories which include Dance, Piano-Classical, Voice-Classical, and Spoken Word and likely have more performances than April 12. We would like to ensure that the evening isn't too long for our younger performers so will divide the evening, with a new start time of 6:30pm for our younger performers.



- No reservation is required for chair seating. There will be no service to those seated in chairs but patrons can go to the bar for drinks

- Younger performers are asked to arrive by 6:15 so that we can give them a chance to come on stage and try the piano if they wish
- Performers will be gathered together near the stage so that performances can be continuous
- After all the younger performers have finished, there will be awards announcements and trophy presentations for those performers

Our older performers will be presented starting at approximately 7:45pm, following the same steps as above.



Revival House will remain open for regular diners but the number of tables available will be reduced so that 120 chairs can be placed in rows in front of the stage.
